(S) [REDACTED], [REDACTED], was interviewed on December 2nd, 2013, at a secure location at the FBI Field Office in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] provided the following information:

(S) [REDACTED] had been asked numerous times by special agents to consent to an interview. After more than two months of refusals, he accepted, he said, "to put this to bed."

(S) SSA [REDACTED] began the interview by explaining that scientific researchers had detected what they believe to be extraterrestrial activity centered in and around CenturyLink Field. That region, SSA [REDACTED] said, had been called AREA 29 by the scientific research team. There was growing belief that [REDACTED] was the source of the extraterrestrial activity -- specifically, that he was an extraterrestrial.

(S) [REDACTED] smiled at this initial line of questioning, but said nothing.

(S) SSAs [REDACTED] then proceeded to ask [REDACTED] to explain his play on the football field. [REDACTED] seemed confused. SSA [REDACTED] pointed out that [REDACTED] is a mere [REDACTED] tall, but routinely knocks down men who are significantly taller, and outweigh him by more than 50 pounds. SSA [REDACTED] noted [REDACTED] 40 time at the NFL combine, suggesting that those speeds -- while excellent by any earthly standard -- seemed to pale in comparison to the speed with which he regularly moved around the football field now. Finally, SSA [REDACTED] noted that teams had all but stopping throwing down the middle of the football field when they played the Seahawks because [REDACTED] batted down or intercepted virtually every ball thrown there.

(S) In response, [REDACTED] explained his success on the football field as the product of dedication, hard work, and

a relentless determination to "adapt and evolve." This phrase, in particular, generated suspicion from special agents.

(S) When asked by SSA [REDACTED] directly if he was, in fact, an alien, [REDACTED] replied, "No, I'm just from Texas." He summarily ended the interview. As he left, however, [REDACTED] did suggest that his teammate, [REDACTED], might be from another planet.
